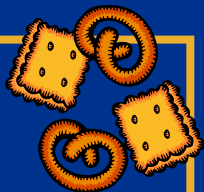


\$1 a week or 1 bottle of water

\$5 a week or 1 double latte

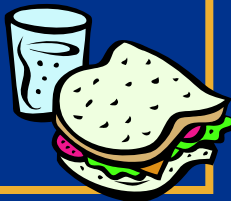
Total annual gift = \$260

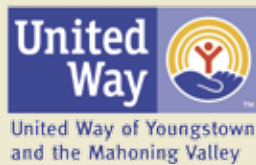

## STRENGTHENING INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES

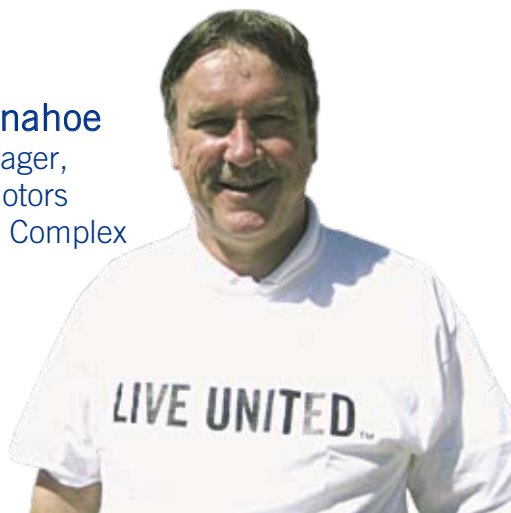
