Women United is the driving force behind United Way's Early Childhood Education Initiatives. This group of dedicated women leads through volunteerism and fundraising to support children and families in the most vulnerable situations. Women United plays a vital role by providing basic needs kits to school districts across our community, emergency funds for students and families in crisis, and financial support to help schools pay for breakfast and lunch debt.

Impact

- Distributed **300 kits** to our partner school districts, including summer learning materials, hygiene items, and winter gear.
- Provided **\$10,000** to local schools for food assistance.
- **30** emergency needs requests to **376** students and families totaling **\$23,700** in 2024.

Care Cart Expansion

- Provided **\$5,000** in funding to expand United Way's Care Cart Initiative in 2 schools.
- Expansion includes Mahoning County Career & Technical Center and Mahoning Valley Community School.
- **849** Care Cart visits
