Women United supports United Way's Early Childhood Education initiatives, bringing together a dedicated group of women committed to uplifting children and families in need. Through volunteerism and fundraising, they help meet critical needs across our community, providing basic needs kits to local school districts and offering emergency support for families in crisis.

Impact

- Fulfilled 42 emergency requests to help students and families with food, beds, clothing, and other essentials.
- Provided funding to school districts to help purchase school supplies and food for students.
- Provided 350 hygiene and newborn essential kits to local schools and agencies through Women's Wednesday.

Crisis Response

- Supported families during the 2025 government shutdown. We distributed 2,500 meal kits across the Mahoning Valley.
- Worked with other agencies to support displaced residents from the Austintown Studio Apartments explosion
